


#### The Diamond Approach®

# The Diamond Heart® Ten ( DH TEN) Program

The Diamond Heart Program is designed specifically for people who sincerely wish to engage the process of self-realization and essential development. The depth and elegant precision of the Teaching makes it appropriate for everyone with a heart-felt wish to know the truth about themselves and reality.

The DH TEN program is an experiential exploration of the Teaching, progressively increasing in depth and subtlety. The combination of group and private work provides a powerful means of deep personal transformation.

### Spiritual Insight

One of the primary ways we practice this path is through personal spiritual insight sessions. In these sessions with a Diamond Approach Teacher, we utilize open-ended inquiry, breathing techniques and movement sequences to allow the soul to open and essence to reveal itself. Each student's personal unfoldment arises naturally and spontaneously.

### Structure, Format & Cost of DH TEN

We will meet six times a year: four 3-day weekends and two 5-day non-residential retreats, on an ongoing basis. We will use talks, experiential exercises, spiritual practice and group discussion. In addition, we will meet one evening per month in group format for deep personal processing. At a certain point students will be invited to participate in teaching retreats offered by A.H. Almaas, the founder of the School.

This path can be a life-long endeavor, but each person finds their optimal involvement.

The cost for the retreats, evening monthly meetings, annual school membership fee and private sessions will average about \$330 per month. Please contact us if the cost is a problem.
